4. NEW BUSINESS

Tropic Weather status:

David KB5PGY reports 50% storm development watch- rain mostly

ARISS Ground Certification updates

Jeff AB4ME reported status of the W5RRR Amateur Radio On the ISS ground station:

- Has had interchanges with Ken McCaughey primary op of ARISS K6DUE @ Goddard
- ARISS committee is currently updating application, requirements and commissioning process for ARISS telebridge stations.
 - o i.e. definitive requirements are not available to guide us today.
- Jeff demonstrated a Proof of Concept of an ARISS non-analog audio configuration
 - Using Google voice @ sans analog POTS line and sans analog phone patch
 - Demonstrated using cell phone call into Google Voice, and porting into radio
- Will plan to conduct dry runs and work out reliability and stability
- Noted that K6DUE (GSFC) has IC-9700 but still using TS2000 today
 - o Not ready to introduce new risk of complexity/configuration change yet

ARISS Backup station

Jeff commented that K6DUE uses TS2000 as prime and another TS2000 as backup John AB5SS concurred with Jeff to the idea of duplicating IC-9700 configuration for backup

• John to investigate potential source to procure an IC-9700

The club agreed to duplicate the IC-9700 primary station as a backup except for the antennas.

Will await John's success to acquire an IC-9700 before beginning the other procurements.

Balloon Project

John AB5SS described recent JSC Student Intern balloon project.

Under compressed 5 days of development and launch, the first JSCARC balloon project was highly successful with extremely enthusiastic students who programmed, built and released 3 balloons. One balloon KI5CWE, is still intermittently sending beacon RF telemetry. Was currently tracked over Central Texas after being aloft for over 10 days.

Physical Accessibility of antenna patch panels

Chris W5HOO reported that it is difficult to change antennas at the patch panel for wheel chaired operators. Though the height of the patch panel was mounted at a standing eye-level, the screw-on PL259 connectors were commented to increase the difficulty to swap cables. Chris suggested using "push-on" connectors. The club agreed to procure them.

Jamboree On The Air

Dave W5OC reported of the JSCARC intention to support the Oct 18-19 JOTA with potential visit with TBD astronaut(s). Jeff AB4ME commented that his recent conversation with Ana, KI5SDP, the JSC ham astronaut liaison, revealed that expectation of crew involvement is TBD, especially since 2 key scout-interested astronauts will now not be available. It was also noted that JOTA on Oct 18-19 competes with multiple public service events that JSCARC members will be supporting, including Wings Over Houston and Bike Around the Bay.
